Dear Ellen,

I am writing in response to your recent correspondence with me (received by the

Department on July 2nd 2025) requesting further information as to government policy in

respect of certain energy matters. As you are undoubtedly aware, any individual decision

in respect of this or other planning applications remains within the remit of An Coimisiún

Pleanála, and I respect fully the independence that An Coimisiún Pleanála exercises in

this regard. This being said, I am happy to clarify the overall policy position in respect of

Ireland's strategic gas reserve and related matters, details of which are set out below.

The Government is committed to taking decisive action to radically reduce our reliance

on fossil fuels and to achieve a 51% reduction in emissions from 2018 to 2030, and to

achieving net-zero emissions no later than 2050.

The Energy Security in Ireland to 2030 report, published in November 2023, states that

Ireland's future energy will be secure by moving from a fossil fuel-based energy system

to an electricity-led system, maximising our renewable energy potential, flexibility and

being integrated into Europe's energy systems.

This review also highlighted a significant risk to Ireland's economy and society in the event of a disruption to gas supplies, that this Government felt needed to be addressed. It is in the context of energy security, that on the 4th March 2025, the <u>Government approved</u> the development of a temporary State-led strategic gas emergency reserve, to secure Ireland's energy systems, as an interim measure, as we continue to transition to an indigenous, clean renewable energy future.

The 2021 'Policy Statement on the Importation of Fracked Gas' notes that the statement will remain in place pending the completion of the review of Ireland's energy security. The approval of this Strategic Gas Emergency Reserve marks that completion. Therefore, The Policy Statement on the Importation of Fracked Gas no longer remains in place.



I have been asked by An Coimisiún Pleanála to refer to the above-mentioned remitted application bearing reference number ABP-322568-25.

An Coimisiún Pleanála previously made a decision on this application by Order dated 13th September, 2023 and under reference number ABP-311233-21. That decision was quashed by Order of the High Court and the case was remitted by that Court back to An Coimisiún Pleanála for a new decision (and upon remittal was given the new 2025 reference number set out above). A copy of the High Court Judgment [2024] IEHC 555 and Order is attached to this letter for your information. Also enclosed for your information is a copy of a notice issued to the applicant in this case.

Having regard to the foregoing, the application has now been reactivated.

In that context, the Commission notes the Government's approval of "a State-led strategic gas emergency reserve that will be in the form of a Floating Storage and Regassification Unit (FSRU), to be owned on behalf of the State by the system operator, Gas Networks Ireland (GNI)", the completion of the review of Ireland's energy security, and the consequent cessation of effect of the "Policy Statement on the Importation of Fracked Gas", all announced by press release on the 4th March, 2025. It is noted that the application in this matter relates to a private FRSU, and not a state led one, in this regard the Commission seeks clarity as to what is the policy in relation to private FRSUs.

Having regard to the foregoing, the Commission considers it appropriate, pursuant to section 37F(1)(c) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, to request the Minister to provide further submissions or observations on the remitted planning application, and in particular, to provide the Commission with information as to what in the Minister's view are the implications of the Government's current policy, as announced on the 4th March 2025, for this application currently under consideration by the Commission (i.e. the remitted application bearing reference number ABP-322568-25).

Any such submissions that you may have in response to this notice must be received on or before 5.30 p.m. on 7th August 2025.
